Present Subjunctive Verbs - express action that is not fact (indefinite, doubt, uncertainty, opinion, emotion, desire, denial) Forming the subjunctive: - use the stem of the present indicative “yo” form - drop “o” & add endings: -ar verbs: -e, -es, -emos, -en -er & -ir verbs: -a, -as, -amos, -an -ir stem changer, nosotros form - e:i & e:ie change “e” to “i” - o:ue change “o” to “u”	Irregular Subjunctive Verbs	
	estar	esté, estemos, estés, esté, estén
	ser	sea, seamos, seas, sea, sean
	ir	vaya, vayamos, vayas, vaya, vayan
	saber	sepa, sepamos, sepas, sepa, sepan
	dar	dé, demos, des, dé, den
	-car (sacar)	-que (saque, saquemos, saques, saque, saquen)
	-gar (apagar)	-gue (apague, apaguemos, apagues, apague, apaguen)
	-zar (almorzar)	-ce (almuerce, almorcemos, almuerces, almuerce, almuercen)

Queremos que laves los platos todos los días.

We want you to wash the plates every day.

Es importante que saquemos la basura por la noche.

It's important that we take out the trash at night.

Limpié la casa para que la familia pueda descansar.

I cleaned the house so that the family could rest.

No es probable que tenga un sofá amarilla.

It's not likely that it would have a yellow couch.

Lo que mi hija desea es que yo la compre una manta rosada.

What my daughter wants is that I would buy her a pink bedspread.

¡No es cierto que mis amigos y yo seamos tontos!

It's not true that my friends and I are stupid!

No creo que ustedes arreglen la cocina todos los días.

I don't believe that you (plural) straighten the kitchen every day.

¿Por qué no vayas a la fiesta mañana?

Why aren't you going to the party tomorrow?

Recomiendo que traigas el libro a clase.

I recommend that you bring the book to class.

¿Esperas que ellos trabajen rápido?

Do you hope that they work quickly?

Les sugiero que vengan temprano.

I suggest that they come early.

Es urgente que lo lleves a la sala de emergencias.

It's urgent that you take him to the emergency room.
